Dear Lyme community,

In 1983, then-librarian Geneva Menge, volunteer extraordinaire Norma Randall, and many community members came up with a fund-raising idea to support Converse Free Library's children's services. The concept of **Blisters for Books** was simple: students would run laps around the Common and gather pledges for each lap completed. This met two goals simultaneously: physical fitness and literacy. Over the subsequent 35 years, we have raised tens of thousands of dollars for this purpose. This activity is one of many ways the library and school collaborate to expand the services available to everyone in town, as well as reduce the impact on taxes to our residents.

As the library has grown, as well as our community as a whole, we are looking to involve more people than just our Lyme School students in this effort. On October 6, we will once again be holding a Blisters for Books event. Several years ago, we began a new tradition of inviting people who may not have a direct connection with a Lyme student to make donations toward this cause directly. To this end, we would invite you again to leave a donation at either the school or the library along with the form on the back of this paper. You may support a particular runner or grade, or just donate directly to the Blisters fund.

The materials paid for with these funds strengthen the resources available for the children in our community, both at the school and the public library.
