3. Library Director's Report

- Library director had a productive meeting with principal John D'Entremont the school wants to take more responsibility for the school library program and instruction of the children. MOU is outdated and needs to be reevaluated
- Summer Reading Program- "All Together Now" theme

- Month of May Stats
 - Almost 3000 total items lent this month. Record since the pandemic is 2936 and we came in at 2929.
 - o 1,300 visitors through the door



- o 83 adults attended programs; 89 attended children's programs
- Separation of School & Public library online catalogs implications of this change and question about making the two work best for the respective users still all one catalog, just two entry points
- Tuesday, June 27, 7pm, David Kotz Lyme resident and Dartmouth provost is happy to give a talk about AI and its implications
- Emergency plan is on the to-do list
- Blisters for Books fundraiser October 5 it will run from 9-11am, not the full day as in years past, based on a request from the school
- SAU is moving out of the library building, potentially in August. They are taking a conference room at the school to create three offices. Their old space will be of great use to the library for for tutoring, patron use, and a processing area

Technology Committee

- Dan Watts, who installed the mesh WiFi system, updated everything recently and let Judy know that the Cloud Key was failing and impacting the internal network. The firmware was out of date and not updateable. He came and replaced and configured it on Sunday, June 4.

- Spring Cleanup Recap- Judy will ask the Friends if there is money available for hostas and plants for the front of the library
- Tim Cook from the Heritage Commission looked at the front steps for repair in consideration of a more permanent solution. Russell Wilcox shared the idea of carving down 3 inches into original concrete and lifting the columns up and supporting the portico while replacing the concrete with granite. Tim thinks a great improvement with more longevity. Judy is going to look at getting a bid to cover the cost.



- Update on solar project approved but delayed. Inspection June 12.
- Exterior painting/lead mitigation begins June 16- the new plantings should hopefully not get trampled or impacted.
