• Brigette Cameron made a motion to approve minutes and Deb Robinson seconded. All were in favor of approving the June meeting minutes

3. Library Director's Report

- Summer Reading Program 2023 recap- 99 students registered and half went through the whole program and returned their forms. 462 attendance, several successful family nights, two book groups got off the ground. 24 individual events. Stella's gave the library a good discount on the dozens of pizzas ordered. Lyme Country Store gave lots of paper goods and support. Next year's theme is "Adventure Begins at your Library"
- All library exterior trim (white) paint has been refreshed (with lead mitigation practices) and Tim Lewis gave a quote for the hand railing paint
- Solar panel installation has begun
- Mah Jongg gathering has become quite popular
- Greg Gorman's show will continue; next up is Jim Chandler's "Illuminated Poems"
- Statistics Report- August was a good month for lending. Adult programming attendance consistently high due to several ongoing programs
- Library director has asked that we resume meeting in August next summer since the summer break is too long between meetings



• SAU office lease; the move is in progress from the library to the school and is predicted by the school to be complete by end of October.

- Relationship with the school has evolved. Book selection and Instruction of grades 1-4 has moved to school away from library. Beginning this school year, all library services are conducted through school. This is the model that Principal D'Entremont has decided upon

- Birthday Book Club has been asked to be an out of school activity to be less disruptive to school time
